Work Session

SB 430

Specifies disclosures that a retail seller must make to a retail buyer for a transaction in goods or services that concludes online by means of a website or other electronic method.

SB 605 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Health Care

Prohibits medical service providers from reporting the amount or existence of medical debt to a consumer reporting agency.

SB 907

Requires an applicant for a license to manufacture psilocybin to submit to the Oregon Health Authority information regarding the ownership and location of the premises to be licensed.

SB 968

Provides requirements for employer deductions for erroneous overpayments of wages for employees who are not subject to a collective bargaining agreement.

SB 1032

Prohibits the retail sale of an aerosol duster that contains 1,1-Difluoroethane to an individual under 21 years of age.

SB 1108

Requires employers to allow employees to take up to four hours of blood donation leave per calendar year without the loss of time, pay or benefits.

Public Hearing and Work Session

SB 1148

Prohibits disability income insurers from requiring a person to use other available benefits for which the person is eligible prior to being eligible for disability benefits offered by the insurer.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 999

Modifies the definition of "farmworker camp" so that the relevant statutes apply to farmworker camps specifically in connection with workers who work on a seasonal or temporary basis.

Note: The public hearing on SB 1061 is for the purpose of taking testimony on the -4 amendment. The committee may consider requesting the addition of a subsequent referral to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

SB 1061

Requires the Director of the Oregon State University Extension Service to establish a lumber grading training program.

Note change: SB 1119 has been removed.
