Public Hearing

- SB 576 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the State Department of Agriculture for the purpose of eradicating Japanese beetle grubs.
- SB 565
Requires the State Parks and Recreation Department to study existing, expanding and establishing state campgrounds within 25 miles of the Oregon coast.
- SB 1076
Directs the State Department of Agriculture to impose certain fees for licenses and license renewals for animal rescue entities.

SB 777 is scheduled solely for the purpose of consideration of the -5 amendments.

Work Session

- SB 777
Provides that compensation for injury to livestock or working dogs under the wolf depredation compensation and financial assistance grant program must be based on fair market value and other factors.
- SB 985 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the State Department of Agriculture for deposit in the Wolf Management Compensation and Proactive Trust Fund.
- SB 579 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys to the State Fire Marshal for distribution to Central Douglas Fire and Rescue for certain purposes.
