SUMMARY

Digest: The Act allows for certain candidates to help county clerks count ballots. (Flesch Readability Score: 69.9).

Permits a precinct committeeperson who appears on the ballot to volunteer as personnel to assist a county clerk with counting ballots.

- 254.476. (1)(a) The county clerk may employ personnel as necessary to open envelopes, handle ballots, prepare ballots for counting and count ballots. The personnel may not all be members of the same political party.
- (b) Except as provided in paragraph (c) of this subsection, a candi-9 date who appears on the ballot at an election, other than an incumbent 10 candidate for county clerk,] or a person who is a member of the household, 11 spouse, domestic partner, child, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, parent, mother-12 in-law, father-in-law, sibling, brother-in-law, sister-in-law, aunt, uncle, niece, 13 nephew, stepparent or stepchild of any candidate who appears on the ballot 14 may not be employed and may not serve as a volunteer [in the capacity de-15 scribed in this section] for the duties described in paragraph (a) of this 16 subsection. 17
