WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Expands the definition of "local correctional facility" under the Oregon Jail-Based Medications for Opioid Use Disorder Grant Program to allow people at other types of county facilities to receive opioid use disorder treatment and transition planning services.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

Under ORS 169.005, "Local correctional facility" means a jail or prison for the reception and confinement of prisoners that is provided, maintained and operated by a county or city and holds persons for more than 36 hours.

House Bill 3009 would amend definitions relevant to the Oregon Jail-Based Medications for Opioid Use Disorder Grant Program created by House Bill 4002 (2024) to allow people at other types of county facilities to receive grant funding for ongoing treatment and transition planning services.
