Agency Mission:


Protect the public by supervising Occupational Therapy practice and to ensure safe and ethical delivery of Occupational Therapy services.

Licensure of Occupational Therapists and Occupational Therapy Assistants within 3 days of receiving all required documentation.


Investigate complaints and take appropriate action when violations occur.

NEW OT EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS

Western Oregon University, Salem, OR – Doctorate program

- ► First public university offering an OT program.

► Fall 2024 starting cohort of 16 and expected to grow to 20-24 for Fall 2025



► KPM 3: Customer satisfaction: Over 95% ratings received of good or excellent. Comments provided anonymously and reviewed by the Board annually to improve current services.



► KPM 4: Board follows best practices: 100%. Reviewed and

measured annually.



2025-2027 GOVERNOR'S BUDGET

- ▶ \$792,907 100% Other Funds
- ▶ 9 months of Ending Balance
- ▶ 75% of revenue comes from renewals
- ► Fees were raised in 21-23 and again in 23-25. Prior to 21-23, the OTLB did not raise its fees for 15 years
- ▶ No fee increase this biennia
- ▶ No fee increases projected through 2029

10% REDUCTION OPTIONS

- ► Decrease Limitation in Office Supplies
- ► Decrease Limitation in Professional Services
- ► Decrease Limitation in Attorney General Legal Fees
