Grant Allocation Increases

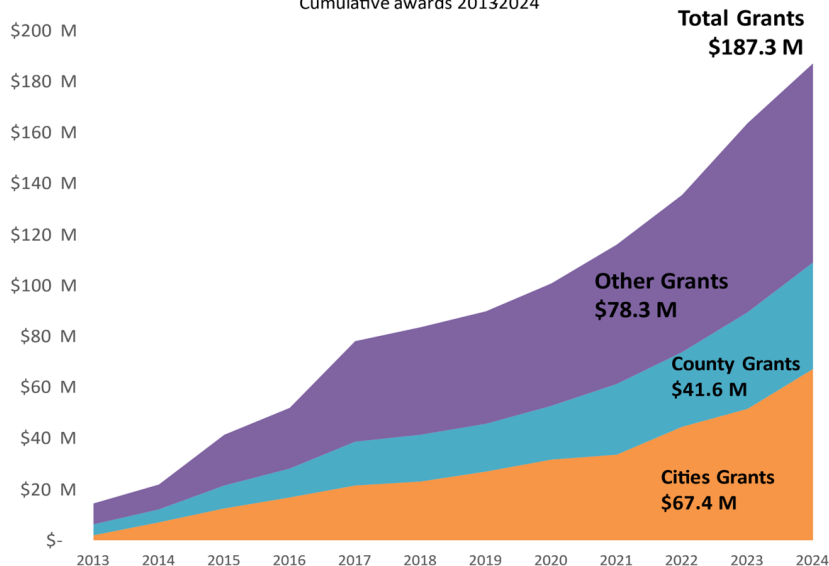
Recreation:

- LGGP increase due to lottery fund dedication shift
- LWCF appropriations grew from about \$600k in 2013 to over \$4M in 2024.
- ATV annual allocations also increased as gas tax revenues increased.

Heritage:

- Updated allocation methods for some federal grants (updated census records).
- Increases to meet growing need
- Legislature created Oregon Main St. Revitalization Grant in 2015.
 - 2017- \$2.5M
 - 2023 - \$5M
 - 2027 - \$10M (additional from 2023 lottery bond package bill)
