Subject: HB 5050 – 2023-25 Bond Authorization  
Work Session Recommendations

HB 5050 amends previously approved bond authorizations.

The -1 amendment replaces the bill and makes the following changes to bonding authorized to be issued in the 2023-25 biennium:

- Article XI-G bond authority for the Higher Education Coordinating Commission is increased by \$2.5 million for Klamath Community College's (KCC) Childcare Resource Learning Center. KCC was originally authorized \$1.5 million in XI-G bonds with the goal of constructing a 7,500 square foot space with a total project cost of \$3.1 million. The project has now expanded in scale to a nearly 29,000 square foot facility with an associated cost of \$17.8 million. The increased authorization will bring the state's total contribution to the project up to \$4 million.
