

**SB 908 STAFF MEASURE SUMMARY**

**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

The measure requires the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission's rules establishing standards for the labeling of marijuana items and industrial hemp vapor items include that the minimum age of 21 years for consumption of such items.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

**EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:**

The Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission's (OLCC) rules regarding labeling of consumer marijuana and consumable hemp-derived items are found at [OAR 845-025-7000 to 845-025-7190](#), including specific labeling requirements by product type. Usable marijuana, and cannabinoid topicals, edibles, concentrates, extracts, tinctures and other cannabinoid products must have a label that includes the warning: "For use only by adults 21 and older. Keep out of reach of children." OAR 845-025-7070 (12), OAR 845-025-7080 (13), OAR 845-025-7090 (17), OAR 845-025-7100 (13), OAR 845-025-7110 (14), OAR 845-025-7120 (14). The rules also prohibit labels that are attractive to minors, as defined in OAR 845-025-7000.
