

HB 3869 STAFF MEASURE SUMMARY

WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

The measure requires the Oregon Department of Energy (ODOE), in collaboration with the Oregon Public Utility Commission (PUC), to study the benefits of a central energy procurement policy. Directs ODOE to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to energy no later than September 15, 2026.

Sunsets on January 2, 2027.

- *REVENUE: May have revenue impact, but no statement issued yet*
