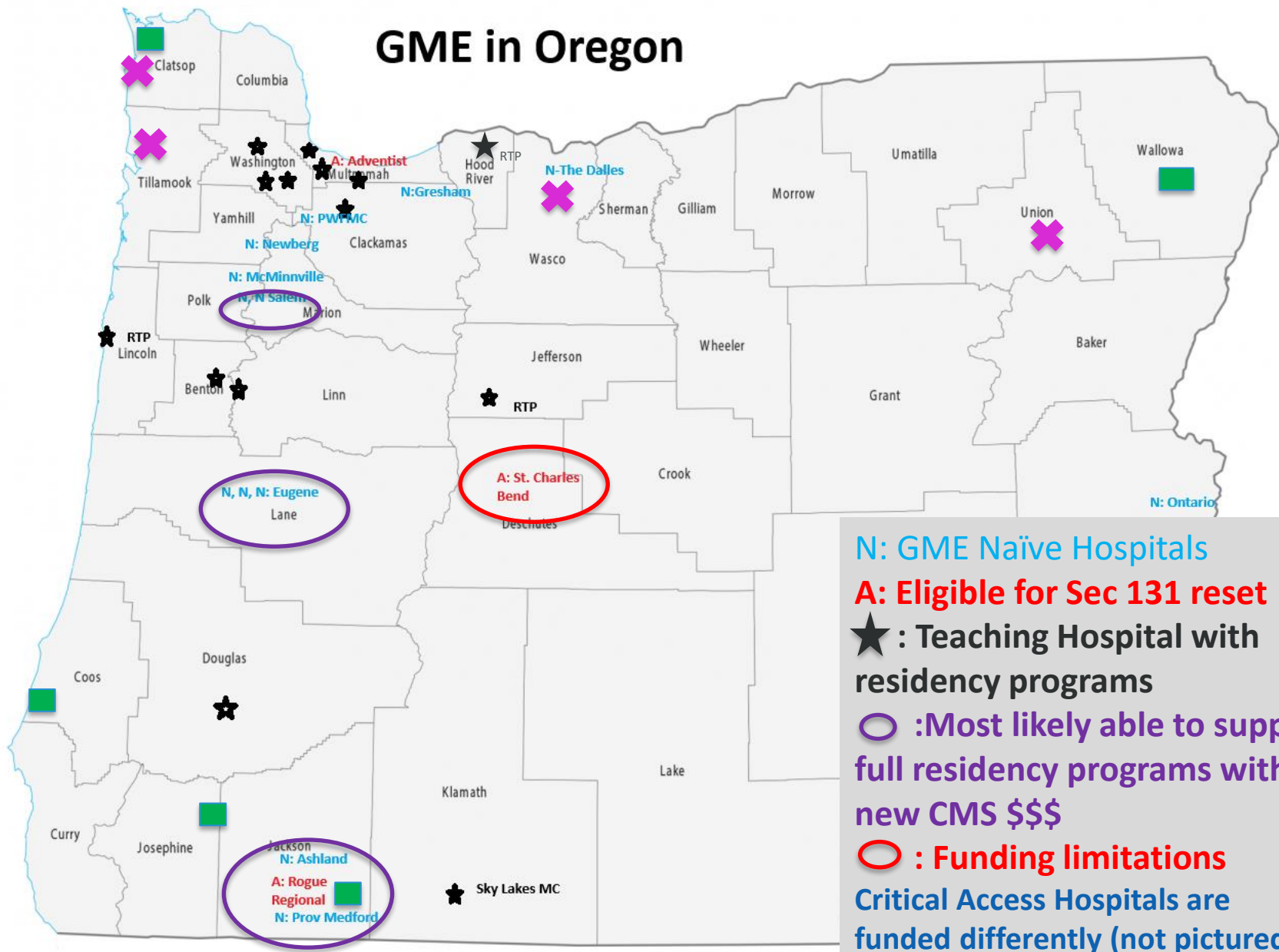

GME in Oregon

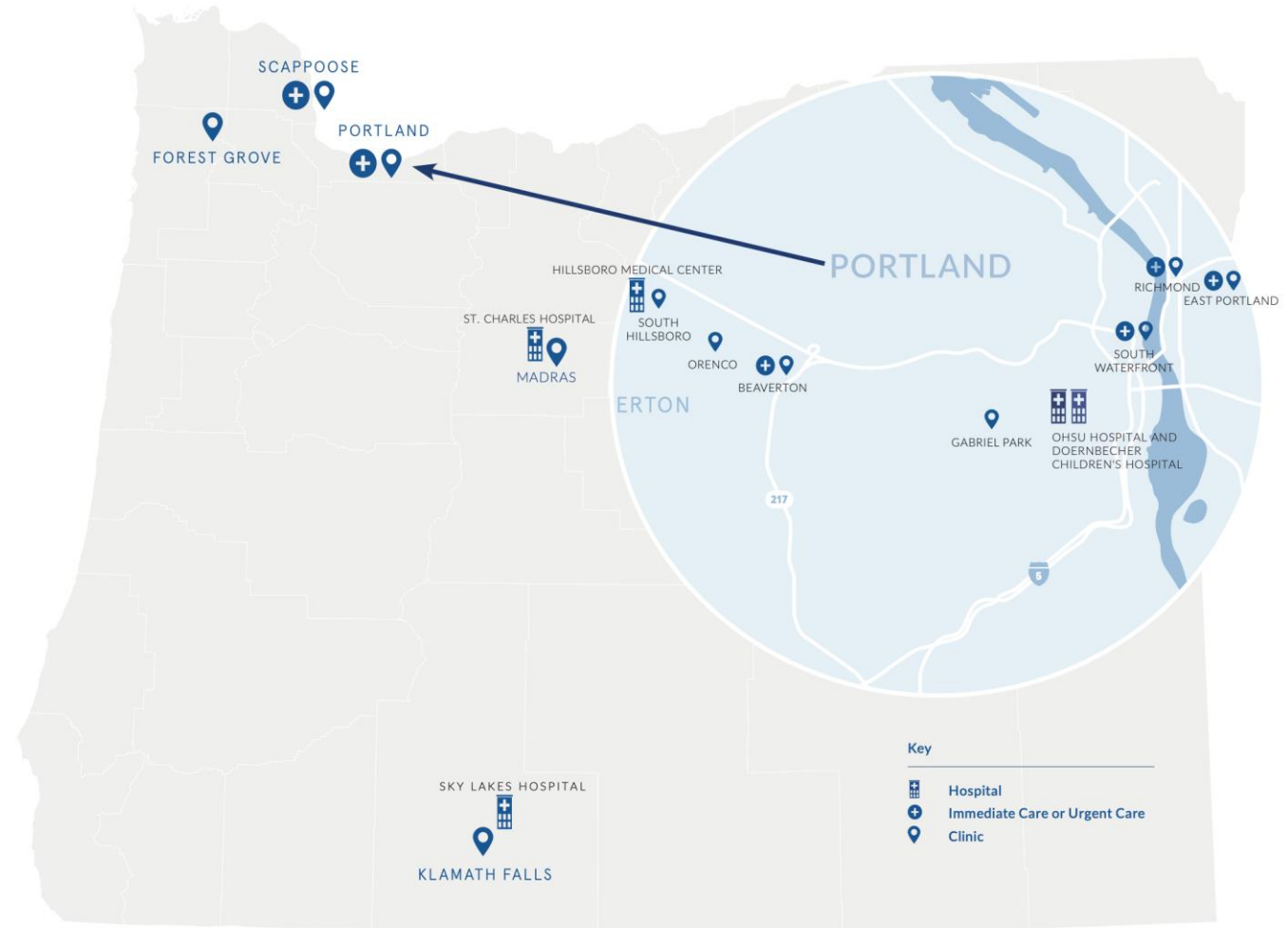


N: GME Naïve Hospitals

OHSU primary care across the state

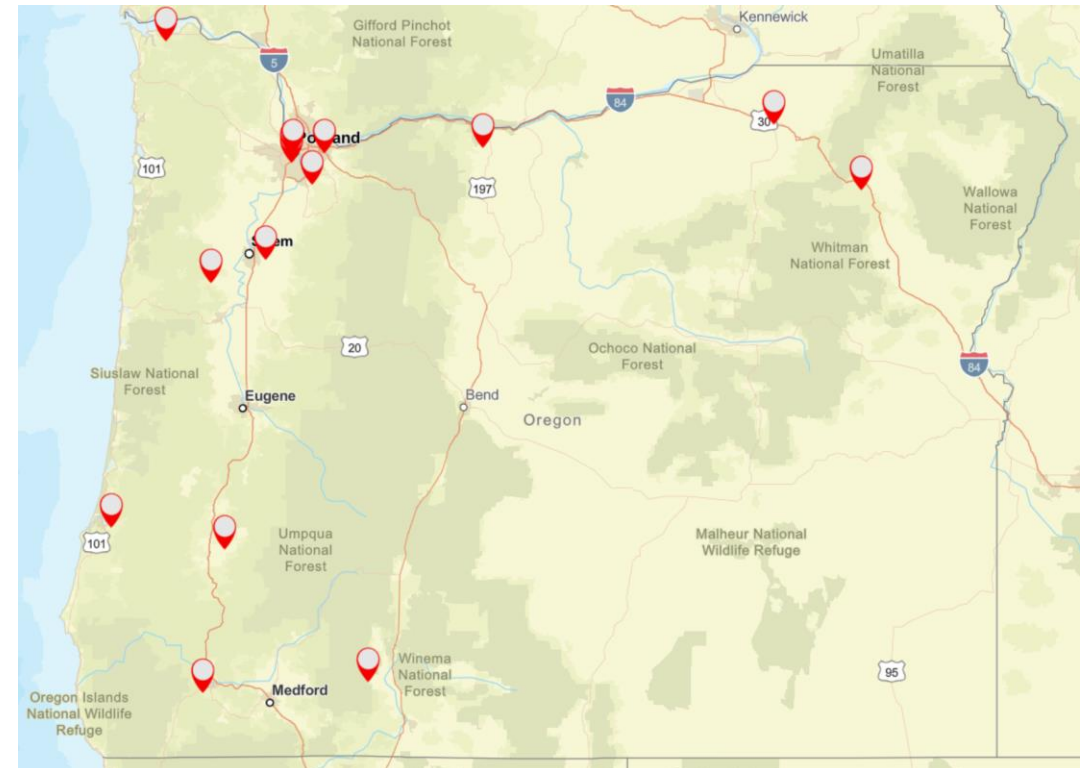
- **Department of Family Medicine: Graduate Medical Education**

OHSU nursing programs throughout Oregon

- Campuses in Portland, La Grande, Monmouth, Klamath Falls and Bend.
- Partnerships with nine community colleges through OCNE.
- Dramatically expanded Oregon's nursing program capacity and enrollment, particularly in rural areas.
- OHSU online degree and programs in nine of the 17 Oregon community colleges.
