Subject: HB 2809 – Relating to pesticide registration fees
Work Session Recommendations

The measure increases the statutory fee cap that the Oregon Department of Agriculture is authorized to charge for pesticide product registration fees from \$400 to \$550. The current cap is expected to be met in the next fee increase cycle, effective January 1, 2026. The increase is necessary for program sustainability to fulfill the regulatory compliance functions, which protect the environment and public health.

The Department's appropriation bill, SB 5502, assumes passage of HB 2809 and includes \$1.2 million in estimated Other Funds revenue for the 2025-27 biennium.

Final Subcommittee Action

LFO recommends that HB 2809 be moved to the Ways and Means Full Committee.
