Subject: SB 1137 – Relating to autologous breast reconstruction
Work Session Recommendations

The measure requires health insurers to provide coverage for autologous breast reconstruction procedures. Additionally, health insurance carriers must satisfy network adequacy standards for these procedures and contract with enough providers to ensure that services are available without an unreasonable delay. The measure is anticipated to have a minimal fiscal impact on the Oregon Health Authority and no fiscal impact on the Department of Consumer and Business Services.

The -A2 amendment makes a correction to the definitions used in the measure. On page 1 line 17 the amendment corrects “Muscle sparking” to “Muscle sparing.” This modification does not change the minimal fiscal impact of the measure.
