

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

HB 3902

Relating to nursing

HB 3902 directs the Oregon State Board of Nursing convene two 13-member advisory committees.

The first committee will examine issues related to staff shortages in nursing education. By March 15, 2026, the committee must submit a report with its legislative and policy recommendations to the Legislature.

The second committee will assess issues in recruiting and retaining registered nurses, licensed practical nurses, and certified nursing assistants. The committee is required to submit a report with its legislative and policy recommendations to the Legislature by December 15, 2026.

The measure permits the Board to contract with an Oregon-based nonprofit organization to facilitate the work of the two committees and provides \$150,000 Other Funds for implementation.

The Capital Construction Subcommittee recommends HB 3902 be reported out do pass.
