

CONFLICT AMENDMENT RECOMMENDATION

HB 3069

Relating to public safety

To: Ways and Means Full Committee

Carrier: Senator Broadman

HB 3069 modifies and consolidates several existing grant review programs administered by the Criminal Justice Commission, changes grant allocation methodologies, makes modifications to the structure and membership of the Commission, and makes modifications to HB 3194 from 2013.

The grants impacted by this bill are appropriated in the Criminal Justice Commission budget bill, HB 5005.

The Joint Committee on Ways and Means previously approved this bill, and it has passed the House.

The –B8 amendment resolves conflicts with SB 236 specific to the behavioral health deflection funding disbursement, and also HB 2632 to resolve specialty courts terminology, repealing those sections and issues that were in conflict. In both cases, HB 3069 comprehensively changes and updates grant programs for the Criminal Justice Commission and supersedes what had been in SB 236 and HB 2632.

I recommend HB 3069 be amended by the –A8 conflict amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
