

CONFLICT AMENDMENT RECOMMENDATION

SB 844

Relating to public health

To: Ways and Means Full Committee

Carrier: Representative Valderrama

SB 844 updates provisions relating to Oregon Health Authority opioid and opiate reporting, psilocybin investigations, environmental health and wastewater specialist and trainee eligibility requirements, and clinical laboratory requirements.

The Joint Committee on Ways and Means previously approved this bill, and it has passed the Senate.

The –B4 amendment resolves conflicts with HB 2387 that result from modifications of ORS 475A.586, relating to psilocybin and information that is exempt from disclosure. The conflict amendment specifies that if HB 2387 were to become law, then the modifications to ORS 475A.586 under this act are repealed and are amended as specified under HB 2387.

I recommend SB 844 be amended by the –B4 conflict amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
