**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

The measure, for the part of the state in the Pacific Time Zone, maintains standard time year-round if California and Washington do the same within 10 years. It permits daylight saving time year-round if Congress authorizes it, and if California and Washington have daylight saving time year-round, within 10 years. It also keeps the part of the state in the Mountain Time Zone unchanged.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Moving the measure back to the President's desk for referral to another committee
