House Bill 2107

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells DOJ to report each year to an interim committee on court cases in the previous year that made the state have to pay money. (Flesch Readability Score: 66.6).

Directs the Department of Justice to report each year to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary on court cases in the previous year that have resulted in a judgment against the state or in a settlement that requires the state to pay money to another party.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to lawsuits involving the state.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. Not later than September 15 of each year, the Department of Justice shall report in the manner provided in ORS 192.245 to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary on court cases in the previous year that have resulted in a judgment against the state or in a settlement that requires the state to pay money to another party. The report must include the names and case numbers of the cases, if applicable, the amounts of the judgments and the amounts to be paid by the state under the settlements.
