3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. An association or organization has standing to seek declaratory relief in the
5	Oregon Tax Court if:
6	(1) One or more members of the association or organization is adversely affected or
7	aggrieved by the subject of the requested declaration;
8	(2) The interests that the association or organization seeks to protect are germane to the
9	purpose of the association or organization; and
LO	(3) The nature of the claim and the relief requested do not require that the members of
11	the association or organization who are adversely affected or aggrieved participate in the
12	proceedings in the Oregon Tax Court.
