## House Bill 2343

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act extends a sunset on a fund. The Act extends a sunset on certain agency authority. The Act extends a sunset on an exemption. (Flesch Readability Score: 66.4).

Extends a sunset on the Columbia River Fisheries Enhancement Fund.

(2) The Columbia River Fisheries Enhancement Fund established under section 7, chapter 672, 8 9 Oregon Laws 2013, is abolished January 2, [2026] 2036. 10 (3) Any unexpended moneys remaining in the Columbia River Fisheries Enhancement Fund on 11 January 2, [2026] 2036, shall be transferred to the State Wildlife Fund. The amendments to ORS 496.146 by section 5 [of this 2021 Act], chapter 169, Oregon 13 14 **Laws 2021,** become operative on January 2, [2026] **2036**. SECTION 3.
