

House Bill 2367

Sponsored by Representative LEVY B; Representatives OSBORNE, SMITH G, WRIGHT, Senator NASH (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells OHA to look at issues with telemedicine. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.3).

Requires the Oregon Health Authority to study issues related to telemedicine. Directs the authority to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health care not later than September 15, 2026.

2 Relating to telemedicine.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Oregon Health Authority shall study issues related to telemedicine. The**
5 **authority shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include**
6 **recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly re-**
7 **lated to health care no later than September 15, 2026.**

8 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.**
