

House Bill 2405

Sponsored by Representative LEVY B; Representatives MANNIX, OWENS, SMITH G (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act would give money to the DOC for the adults in custody at some prisons in the eastern part of Oregon to get an education. (Flesch Readability Score: 60.0).

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Department of Corrections for distribution to some department institutions in eastern Oregon for the purpose of providing educational programs to adults in custody.

Declares an emergency, effective July 1, 2025.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to funding education programs for adults in custody in eastern Oregon; and declaring an

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
6 **ated to the Department of Corrections, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the**
7 **General Fund, the amount of \$____, to be distributed to the Snake River Correctional In-**
8 **stitution, Eastern Oregon Correctional Institution, Powder River Correctional Facility and**
9 **Two Rivers Correction Institution for the purpose of providing education programs to adults**
10 **in custody.**

11 **SECTION 2. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
12 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect**
13 **July 1, 2025.**
