

House Bill 2420

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Economic Development, Small Business, and Trade for Representative Daniel Nguyen)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act would have Business Oregon study the funding of sports in this state. The Act would require a report of the findings to be turned in next year. (Flesch Readability Score: 81.2).

Requires the Oregon Business Development Department to study sports funding in Oregon. Directs the department to submit its findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to economic development not later than September 15, 2026.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to sports funding.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Oregon Business Development Department shall conduct a study of the**
5 **funding of sports in Oregon. Not later than September 15, 2026, the department shall submit**
6 **a report of the findings of the study, in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, to the interim**
7 **committees of the Legislative Assembly related to economic development, and may include**
8 **recommendations for legislation in the report.**

9 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.**
