SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act changes when a person is guilty except for insanity. The Act takes effect on the 91st day after sine die. (Flesch Readability Score: 72.6).

Modifies when a person is guilty except for insanity. Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to guilty except for insanity; creating new provisions; amending ORS 161.295; and pre-3

scribing an effective date.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 161.295 is amended to read: 5

161.295. (1) A person is guilty except for insanity if, [as a result of a qualifying mental 6

7 disorder] at the time of engaging in criminal conduct, the person lacks substantial capacity either

8 to appreciate the criminality of the conduct or to conform the conduct to the requirements of law,

9 and the incapacity is primarily the result of a qualifying mental disorder.

(2) As used in chapter 743, Oregon Laws 1971, the term "qualifying mental disorder" does not 10 include an abnormality manifested only by repeated criminal or otherwise antisocial conduct, nor 11 12 does the term include any abnormality constituting solely a personality disorder.

SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 161.295 by section 1 of this 2025 Act apply to con-13duct occurring on or after the effective date of this 2025 Act. 14

15SECTION 3. This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2025 regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die. 16
