House Bill 2557

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act makes it illegal to raise octopus as food for humans or take part in the sale of octopus that was raised as food for humans. (Flesch Readability Score: 69.7).

Prohibits a person from raising octopus for the purpose of human consumption or participating in the sale or offer for sale of octopus that was raised for human consumption.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to octopus. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part of the wildlife laws. 4 SECTION 2. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 498.038 (2), in this state, a person may not: 5 (a) Raise octopus for the purpose of human consumption. 6 (b) Sell, offer for sale or otherwise participate in the sale or offer for sale of octopus that is raised for the purpose of human consumption. 8 (2) This section does not apply to raising octopus for the purpose of: 9 10 (a) Facilitating the keeping of octopus as pets. (b) Laboratory research, as defined in ORS 609.410. 11 (3) A violation of this section shall be subject to the schedule of civil penalties described 12
