

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2566

By COMMITTEE ON CLIMATE, ENERGY, AND ENVIRONMENT

1       On page 4 of the printed bill, line 33, after the period insert “Systems, technologies, equipment  
2 or measures associated with a distribution system may be eligible to be considered as part of a  
3 stand-alone energy resilience project. Rules adopted under this paragraph may not allow, as part of  
4 a stand-alone energy resilience project, the construction, installation or repair of an energy gener-  
5 ation system that is not a renewable energy system.”.

6       On page 5, delete lines 21 through 24 and insert:

7       “(B) 50 percent or more for grants to be awarded for the following:

8       “(i) Planning or developing community renewable energy projects that primarily serve one or  
9 more qualifying communities; or

10       “(ii) Developing stand-alone energy resilience projects that primarily serve one or more quali-  
11 fying communities.

12       “(b) For each opportunity announcement for developing a stand-alone energy resilience project  
13 that the department issues, the department shall allocate, out of the moneys made available in the  
14 calendar interval for all grants under the Community Renewable and Resilient Energy Grant Pro-  
15 gram, 20 percent for grants for developing stand-alone energy resilience projects. The department  
16 may reallocate moneys that were initially allocated but not awarded under an opportunity an-  
17 nouncement for developing a stand-alone energy resilience project that the department issues.”.

18       In line 30, delete “(b)” and insert “(c)”.

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
