House Bill 2590

Sponsored by Representative HUDSON (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Tells a franchisor not to make a franchisee buy goods or services from the franchisor or a source the franchisor favors. Lists some exceptions. Says that a franchisor may not get money, goods or a benefit from a person that does business with a franchisee unless the franchisor passes the money, goods or benefit to the franchisee right away. Lists an exception. (Flesch Readability Score: 64.9).

Prohibits a franchisor from requiring a franchisee to purchase goods, supplies, inventories or services from the franchisor or a source the franchisor designates if goods, supplies, inventories or services of comparable quality are available elsewhere. Specifies exceptions.

Prohibits a franchisor from receiving payment, goods, services or any other benefit from a per-son with which a franchisee does business unless the franchisor accounts for and transmits to the franchisee the payment, goods, service or benefit. Specifies exceptions.

2 Relating to prohibited provisions in franchise agreements.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3

SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 650.005 to 4 650.100.

SECTION 2. (1)(a) A franchisor may not require as part of a franchise that the franchisee 6 purchase goods, supplies, inventories or services solely from the franchisor or a source the 7 8 franchisor designates if goods, supplies, inventories or services of comparable quality are available from sources other than the franchisor or the sources that the franchisor desig-9 10 nates, except that the franchisor may:

11 (A) Publish a list of approved sources of goods, supplies, inventories or services that comply with a published set of the franchisor's specifications and standards; and 12

13(B) Disapprove sources of goods, supplies, inventories or services that do not comply with the franchisor's published specifications and standards. 14

15(b) Paragraph (a) of this subsection does not apply to goods, supplies, inventories or 16 services that the franchisor manufactures or that bear the franchisor's trademark.

(2)(a) Except as provided in paragraph (b) of this subsection, a franchisor may not receive 1718 from a person with which a franchisee does business a payment, a provision of goods or 19 services or of any other benefit if the payment, provision or benefit arises as a consequence 20 of or in relation to the franchisee's transaction with the person, unless the franchisor 21promptly accounts for and transmits the payment, provision or benefit to the franchisee.

22(b) A franchisor may receive compensation for services the franchisor provides to the 23person or the franchisee in enabling or facilitating the transaction between the person and the franchisee. 24

25SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2025 Act applies to franchises into which a franchisor and
