## House Bill 2616

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells the CJC to do a study. (Flesch Readability Score: 100.0). Directs the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to study recidivism rates of persons granted a pardon and to provide the results of the study to the appropriate interim committees of the Legislative Assembly no later than December 31, 2026.

Sunsets January 2, 2027.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to pardons.
- Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
  - <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission shall study recidivism rates of persons granted a pardon.
  - (2) The commission shall provide the results of the study, including any recommended legislative changes, in a report to the appropriate interim committees of the Legislative Assembly in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 no later than December 31, 2026.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
