## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Tells OJD to study privacy and report back. (Flesch Readability Score: 71.3). Requires the Judicial Department to study privacy. Directs the department to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary no later than September 15, 2026.

Sunsets on January 2, 2027.

SECTION 1. The Judicial Department shall study privacy. The department shall submit 4

a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for leg-5

islation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary no 6

later than September 15, 2026. 7

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027. 8
