## House Bill 2736

Sponsored by Representative HUDSON (Presession filed.)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act directs ODE to study the needs of school districts that serve certain students in out-of-home placements. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.6).

Requires the Department of Education to study how school districts serve students who have been voluntarily placed outside the students' homes with public or private agencies. Directs the department to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to education not later than September 15, 2026.

Sunsets on January 2, 2027.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- Relating to education of students in voluntary placements.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
  - SECTION 1. The Department of Education shall study the needs of school districts regarding serving students who have been voluntarily placed outside of the students' homes with public or private agencies. The department shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to education no later than September 15, 2026.
  - SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
