House Bill 2762

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act says it is an offense to sleep in danger zone near the road. (Flesch Readability Score: 95.4).

Creates the offense of sleeping in a highway danger zone. Punishes by a maximum fine of \$250.

person sleeps on the ground within 10 feet of the outside edge or curb of the roadway any
time from sunset to sunrise.

9 (2) The offense described in this section, sleeping in a highway danger zone, is a Class D
