

House Bill 2972

Sponsored by Representatives GOMBERG, MANNIX, Senator FREDERICK; Representative DRAZAN, Senators GORSEK, MANNING JR (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act provides OED money for staffing certain workforce programs. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.3).

Provides funding to the Employment Department for staffing workforce reentry programs for adults in custody.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to funding for staffing workforce reentry programs; and prescribing an effective date.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
5 **ated to the Employment Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the**
6 **General Fund, the amount of \$3,000,000, which may be expended for staffing workforce re-**
7 **entry programs for adults in custody delivered through the WorkSource Oregon system.**

8 **SECTION 2. This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2025**
9 **regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**
