House Bill 2973

Sponsored by Representative GOMBERG, Senator ANDERSON (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act would direct the Department of State Lands to study how to fund the cleanup of the public waterways in this state. The Act would require a report of the study to be submitted next year. (Flesch Readability Score: 73.7).

Requires the Department of State Lands to study options for funding for marine cleanup. Directs the department to submit a report of the study to the interim committees of the Legislative Assem-

bly related to the use of the state's public waterways no later than September 15, 2026.

Sunsets January 2, 2027.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to funding for marine cleanup.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The Department of State Lands shall conduct a study of funding options for

5 marine cleanup, including removal of abandoned and derelict vessels. The department shall

6 submit a report of its findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related

7 to the use of the state's public waterways in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 no later

8 than September 15, 2026.

9 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
