House Bill 2984

Sponsored by Representatives HELM, OWENS (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act gives money to an agency for deposit into a certain fund. The Act says that the money must be used for activities related to water. (Flesch Readability Score: 64.6).

Appropriates moneys to the State Department of Fish and Wildlife out of the General Fund for deposit into the Oregon Conservation and Recreation Fund.

Declares an emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to funding for activities concerning water; and declaring an emergency.
- Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - <u>SECTION 1.</u> There is appropriated to the State Department of Fish and Wildlife, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,500,000, for deposit into the Oregon Conservation and Recreation Fund established by ORS 496.252 for activities described in ORS 496.252 (2) that relate to water.
 - SECTION 2. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect on its passage.
