House Bill 3011

Sponsored by Representative NERON; Representatives PHAM H, WRIGHT, Senators BROADMAN, CAMPOS, FREDERICK, PATTERSON (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act creates a fund for childhood teaching development at HECC. The Act declares an emergency. The Act becomes law on July 1, 2025. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.2). Establishes the Early Childhood Education Workforce Development Fund and appropriates

Establishes the Early Childhood Education Workforce Development Fund and appropriates moneys in the fund to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to provide funding to community colleges and public universities in this state that offer early childhood education degrees and certificates.

Declares an emergency, effective July 1, 2025.

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A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the Early Childhood Education Workforce Development Fund; and declaring an emer-3 gency.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) There is established in the State Treasury, separate and distinct from the

- 6 General Fund, the Early Childhood Education Workforce Development Fund. All moneys in
- 7 the fund are continuously appropriated to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for

8 purposes of carrying out this section.

9 (2) The Higher Education Coordinating Commission shall administer the fund.

(3) The fund consists of moneys appropriated, allocated, deposited or transferred to the
 fund by the Legislative Assembly or otherwise.

(4) The commission shall distribute moneys in the fund to community colleges operated
 under ORS chapter 341 and public universities listed in ORS 352.002 based on the following
 formula:

(a) One-third of the moneys shall be distributed to those community colleges and public
 universities that offer early childhood education degrees and certificate programs;

(b) One-third of the moneys shall be distributed to those community colleges and public
universities with campus-based childcare and learning centers that offer on-the-job training
for students enrolled in early childhood education degree programs; and

(c) One-third of the moneys shall be distributed to community colleges and public uni versities based on the number of early childhood education degrees and certificates granted,
 with the first distribution to be based on an average of the degrees and certificates granted
 in the preceding three years.

24 <u>SECTION 2.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-25 ated to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 26 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$20,000,000 which shall be transferred to the 27 Early Childhood Education Workforce Development Fund to carry out the purposes of sec1 tion 1 of this 2025 Act.

2 <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public

peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect
July 1, 2025.

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
