## House Bill 3066

Sponsored by Representative NERON; Representative TRAN, Senators FREDERICK, REYNOLDS (Presession filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act gives money to the DOC for a program for adults in custody. (Flesch Readability Score: 77.8).

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Department of Corrections for purpose of funding the advanced esthetics program at the Coffee Creek Correctional Facility.

Declares an emergency, effective July 1, 2025.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the advanced esthetics program at the Coffee Creek Correctional Facility; and declaring

an emergency.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-

6 ated to the Department of Corrections, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the

7 General Fund, the amount of \$180,135, for the purpose of funding the advanced esthetics

8 program at the Coffee Creek Correctional Facility.

9 <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
10 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect
11 July 1, 2025.
