

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3129

By COMMITTEE ON HIGHER EDUCATION AND WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 20, delete the second “and” and insert “or”.

2 In line 22, after “to” insert “individuals who may be”.

3 On page 2, line 7, delete “and” and insert a comma and after “352.002” insert “and Oregon  
4 Health and Science University”.

5 In line 8, after “of” delete the rest of the line and delete line 9 and insert “providers working  
6 in the publicly funded behavioral health system.”.

7 In line 14, after “in” delete the rest of the line and insert “the publicly funded behavioral health  
8 system and that include a service obligation of at least two years;”.

9 In line 19, delete “for supervisors of interns” and insert “related to the supervision of interns  
10 or associates”.

11 In line 29, delete “County” and insert “Community”.

12 In line 30, after “Other” insert “public” and after “employers” insert “organizations”.

13 After line 42, insert:

14 **“SECTION 3. Not later than June 30 of each year, each college and university receiving  
15 moneys under section 2 of this 2025 Act shall report to the Higher Education Coordinating  
16 Commission on the progress and outcomes of the moneys received by the college or univer-  
17 sity. The report must include:**

18 **“(1) The name of any behavioral health training program funded in whole or in part with  
19 the moneys received;**

20 **“(2) The number of students participating in behavioral health training programs made  
21 available as a result of moneys received;**

22 **“(3) The number of students completing training that results in a degree or certificate  
23 in the student’s selected field;**

24 **“(4) The number of students failing to complete training that results in a degree or cer-  
25 tificate in the student’s selected field after the student began a training program;**

26 **“(5) The number of students placed in careers in behavioral health, and including the type  
27 of setting and location of the placement; and**

28 **“(6) An anonymous and aggregated list of the number of students who received financial  
29 assistance under section 2 of this 2025 Act as categorized by the following:**

30 **“(a) Age;**

31 **“(b) Ethnicity;**

32 **“(c) Gender;**

33 **“(d) Race;**

34 **“(e) Disability;**

35 **“(f) Language or languages spoken;**

1       “(g) Sexual orientation; and

2       “(h) County of residence.

3       “**SECTION 4.** Section 3 of this 2025 Act first applies to June 30, 2026.

4       “**SECTION 5.** Not later than September 1 of each year, the Higher Education Coordinat-  
5 ing Commission shall submit a report, in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, setting forth  
6 the progress and outcomes of the provisions of section 2 of this 2025 Act and including the  
7 data described in section 3 of this 2025 Act, to the interim committees of the Legislative  
8 Assembly related to behavioral health.

9       “**SECTION 6.** Section 5 of this 2025 Act first applies to September 1, 2026.”.

10       In line 43, delete “3” and insert “7”.

11       In line 45, delete “\$17,900,000” and insert “\$25,700,000”.

12       On page 3, line 3, delete “4” and insert “8”.

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
