## House Bill 3180

## **SUMMARY**

4	Whereas Washington County's courthouse facilities do not have sufficient space for the number
5	of judges and staff needed to meet community needs and act in a timely manner to address the

9	Whereas Washington County's courthouse facilities can be difficult to access for persons with

12	safety concerns for courthouse staff and the public; and
13	Whereas Washington County has set aside \$1,250,000 in local matching funds, but cannot begin
14	the project until they receive state matching funds; now, therefore,
15	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
16	SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-
17	ated to the Judicial Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General
18	Fund, the amount of \$1,250,000, which may be expended for the Washington County Court-
