SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act would appropriate funds to support the arts and culture in Oregon. (Flesch Readability Score: 63.4).

Appropriates moneys to support arts and cultural organizations in Oregon.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to support of cultural organizations; creating new provisions; and amending section 6, chapter 786, Oregon Laws 2013.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$8,875,000 for distribution in accordance with section 2 of this 2025 Act.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall distribute the amount appropriated under section 1 of this 2025 Act to the following organizations:

There is appropriated to the Oregon Business Development Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$400,000 for deposit in the Cultural Resources Economic Fund established under section 6, chapter 786, Oregon Laws 2013, to be used for any purpose for which moneys in the fund may be used.

SECTION 4. Section 6, chapter 786, Oregon Laws 2013, as amended by section 27, chapter 812, Oregon Laws 2015, section 23, chapter 748, Oregon Laws 2017, section 36, chapter 671, Oregon Laws 2019, section 45, chapter 682, Oregon Laws 2021, and section 41, chapter 599, Oregon Laws 2023, is amended to read:

Sec. 6. (1) The Cultural Resources Economic Fund is established in the State Treasury, separate and distinct from the General Fund. Interest earned on the moneys in the Cultural Resources Economic Fund shall be credited to the fund.

- (2) The Cultural Resources Economic Fund consists of:
- (a) Moneys deposited in the fund under:
 - (A) Section 5, chapter 786, Oregon Laws 2013[,];
 - (B) Section 26, chapter 812, Oregon Laws 2015[,];
- (C) Section 22, chapter 748, Oregon Laws 2017[,];
- (**D**) Section 44, chapter 682, Oregon Laws 2021[, and];
 - (E) Section 38, chapter 599, Oregon Laws 2023 [of this 2023 Act, and may include]; and
 - (F) Section 3 of this 2025 Act; and
 - (b) Fees, revenues or other income deposited in the fund by the Legislative Assembly.
 - [(2)] (3) Moneys in the fund are continuously appropriated to the Oregon Business Development Department for disbursement for the purposes set forth in section 5, chapter 786, Oregon Laws 2013, section 26, chapter 812, Oregon Laws 2015, section 22, chapter 748, Oregon Laws 2017, section 44, chapter 682, Oregon Laws 2021, and section 38, chapter 599, Oregon Laws 2023 [of this 2023 Act].
 - SECTION 5. There is appropriated to the Oregon Business Development Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$50,000 for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of section 6 of this 2025 Act.
 - SECTION 6. (1) The Oregon Business Development Department shall conduct a competitive grant program to award the moneys appropriated under section 5 of this 2025 Act to a nonprofit organization whose mission is to create a thriving environment for arts, culture, history, heritage and humanities throughout Oregon.
 - (2)(a) The nonprofit organization awarded the grant shall use the moneys to fund its provision of technical assistance to the arts and cultural organizations of its selection.
 - (b) The technical assistance provided under this subsection shall consist of assistance with:
 - (A) Receiving and expending public moneys; and
 - (B) Preparing applications for public moneys.

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
