SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act gives money to DOJ to backfill reductions in VOCA grants. (Flesch Readability Score: 74.8).

Appropriates moneys to the Department of Justice to backfill reductions in federal Victims of Crime Act grants.

Declares an emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state finance; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-

5 ated to the Department of Justice, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the Gen-

6 eral Fund, the amount of \$_____, which may be expended for backfilling reductions in

7 federal Victims of Crime Act grants.

8 <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 9 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect 10 on its passage.
