House Bill 3222

Sponsored by Representative NATHANSON; Representative MCLAIN, Senators FREDERICK, WEBER (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Tells ODE to update a survey on the tests given to students in this state. (Flesch Readability Score: 84.4).

Directs the Department of Education to review and update information collected for a survey of the academic assessments administered to the students of this state by school districts. Requires the department to submit an updated report to the State Board of Education and to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to education no later than December 15, 2026.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to academic assessments administered to students by school districts.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - **SECTION 1.** The Department of Education shall:
 - (1) Review the information collected from school districts for the purpose of section 1, chapter 71, Oregon Laws 2022, and identify information that is incomplete, clearly inaccurate or likely inaccurate.
 - (2) Request the school district responsible for the provision of the information identified in subsection (1) of this section to submit or resubmit information that is complete and accurate. The department shall provide assistance to the school district to ensure that the information collected is complete and accurate.
 - (3) Update the report required under section 1 (6), chapter 71, Oregon Laws 2022, to:
 - (a) Reflect information collected as provided by subsection (2) of this section; and
 - (b) Include recommendations and best practices for surveying teachers and classified school employees about time spent to plan, prepare and administer academic assessments required by the school district and the perceived usefulness of the assessments.
 - (4) Submit the updated report prepared under subsection (3) of this section to the State Board of Education and an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to education no later than December 15, 2026.
 - SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.

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
