

House Bill 3239

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act gives funds to DHS and OSP to do programs about criminal records checks. (Flesch Readability Score: 78.8).

Appropriates moneys to the Department of Human Services and the Department of State Police for implementation of programs related to criminal records checks, including the Rap Back program. Declares an emergency, effective on passage.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
5 **ated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of**
6 **the General Fund, the amount of \$_____, which may be expended for participation by the**
7 **background check unit of the department in the Rap Back program, as defined in ORS**
8 **181A.205.**

9 **SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
10 **ated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of**
11 **the General Fund, the amount of \$_____, which may be expended for subsidizing the costs**
12 **to employees of criminal records checks.**

13 **SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
14 **ated to the Department of State Police, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the**
15 **General Fund, the amount of \$_____, which may be expended for implementing the Rap**
16 **Back program, as defined in ORS 181A.205.**

17 **SECTION 4. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
18 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect**
19 **on its passage.**
