SUMMARY

Digest: Tells OHA to study the effects of House Bill 2697 and give a report on its findings. (Flesch Readability Score: 65.1).

Requires the Oregon Health Authority to study the effects of House Bill 2697 (2023). Directs the authority to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health care not later than September 15, 2026.

Sunsets January 2, 2027.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

Relating to staffing plans for health care provider entities; and prescribing an effective date. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. The Oregon Health Authority shall study the effects of chapter 507, Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill 2697 (2023)). The authority shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health care no later than September 15, 2026.

9 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2025 regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
