

House Bill 3398

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON RULES (at the request of Representative Ben Bowman)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells DAS to look at state administration and make a report. (Flesch Readability Score: 76.5).

Requires the Oregon Department of Administrative Services to study state administration and submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to general government not later than September 15, 2026.

Sunsets on January 2, 2027.

Relating to state administration.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall study state administration. The department shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to general government no later than September 15, 2026.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
