

House Bill 3733

Sponsored by Representative HARTMAN

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act gives money to DAS to give to a nonprofit for a Head Start facility. (Flesch Readability Score: 74.2).

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services for distribution to the Clackamas County Children's Commission for a Head Start facility.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration; and prescribing an effective date.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
5 **ated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the biennium beginning July**
6 **1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$4,160,000 for distribution to the Clackamas**
7 **County Children's Commission, a domestic nonprofit corporation, to be used for a Head Start**
8 **facility in Gladstone.**

9 **SECTION 2. This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2025**
10 **regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**
