

# House Bill 3775

Sponsored by Representative ANDERSEN, Senator GELSER BLOUIN; Senator PATTERSON

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act gives money to DAS to give to the City of Salem for a Fairview Training Center plaza and memorial. (Flesch Readability Score: 60.6).

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services for distribution to the City of Salem for a plaza and memorial on the former site of the Fairview Training Center.

Declares an emergency, effective July 1, 2025.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**  
5 **ated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the biennium beginning July**  
6 **1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,500,000 for distribution to the City of**  
7 **Salem for the design and construction of a plaza and memorial on the former site of the**  
8 **Fairview Training Center in South Salem.**

9 **SECTION 2. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
10 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect**  
11 **July 1, 2025.**
