

House Bill 3792

Sponsored by Representative ANDERSEN; Senators MEEK, REYNOLDS

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Tells the PUC to study consumer protection for ratepayers. Tells the PUC to give a report on its findings. (Flesch Readability Score: 68.0).

Requires the Public Utility Commission to study consumer protection for utility ratepayers. Directs the commission to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to energy not later than September 15, 2026.

Sunsets on January 2, 2027.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to consumer protection for utility ratepayers.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Public Utility Commission shall study consumer protection for utility**
5 **ratepayers. The commission shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245,**
6 **and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legisla-**
7 **tive Assembly related to energy no later than September 15, 2026.**

8 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.**
