

# HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5019

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 Delete lines 5 through 27 of the printed bill and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
3 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limits for payment  
4 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-  
5 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Liquor and  
6 Cannabis Commission, for the following purposes:

- 7 (1) Distilled spirits, public  
8 safety, administration and  
9 agency support..... \$148,606,774
- 10 (2) Marijuana regulation  
11 - recreational ..... \$ 34,278,768
- 12 (3) Marijuana regulation  
13 - medical ..... \$ 7,141,879
- 14 (4) Agents’ compensation  
15 - all other..... \$175,666,624
- 16 (5) Agents’ compensation  
17 - distillery agents..... \$ 10,947,086
- 18 (6) Capital improvements ..... \$ 258,159
- 19 (7) Debt service ..... \$ 27,856,722

20 “**SECTION 2.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, expenditures by the Oregon Liquor  
21 and Cannabis Commission for liquor purchases are not limited.

22 “**SECTION 3.** This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
23 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect  
24 July 1, 2025.”
