

# A-Engrossed House Bill 5024

Ordered by the House June 11  
Including House Amendments dated June 11

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act creates an agency budget. (Flesch Readability Score: 73.8).

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Oregon Business Development Department for certain biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the department for certain purposes.

Limits biennial expenditures by the department from specified funds for specified purposes.

Limits biennial expenditures by the department from lottery moneys for certain purposes.

Limits biennial expenditures by the department from federal funds for certain purposes.

Authorizes certain nonlimited expenditures.

Declares an emergency, effective July 1, 2025.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to the financial administration of the Oregon Business Development Department; and declaring an emergency.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1.** There are appropriated to the Oregon Business Development Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for the following purposes:

(1) Operations.....	\$	401,613
(2) Infrastructure.....	\$	807,749
(3) Arts.....	\$	4,818,295
(4) Debt service .....	\$	111,134,553

**SECTION 2.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Business Development Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,685,000, for infrastructure, for grants approved in section 497, chapter 114, Oregon Laws 2024.

**SECTION 3.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Business Development Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$77,160,206, for infrastructure, for grants approved in section 9, chapter 109, Oregon Laws 2024.

**SECTION 4.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there are appropriated to the Oregon Business Development Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for infrastructure, for grants ap-

43 **SECTION 9.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of  
44 \$197,247,462 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for  
45 payment of expenses by the Oregon Business Development Department, from American

1 Rescue Plan Act Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund moneys received by the Oregon  
2 Department of Administrative Services and transferred to the Oregon Business Development  
3 Department, for infrastructure, for grants approved in section 196, chapter 669, Oregon Laws  
4 2021.

5 **SECTION 10.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
6 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limits for payment  
7 of expenses by the Oregon Business Development Department, from the Broadband Fund  
8 established by ORS 285A.167, for the following purposes:

- 9 (1) Operations..... \$ 546,916
- 10 (2) Infrastructure..... \$108,002,343

11 **SECTION 11.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
12 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limits for payment  
13 of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic De-  
14 velopment Fund to the Oregon Business Development Department, for the following pur-  
15 poses:

- 17 (2) Business, innovation  
18 and trade..... \$ 78,857,998
- 19 (3) Infrastructure..... \$ 21,039,054
- 20 (4) Oregon Film and Video Office .. \$ 1,541,600

22 **SECTION 12.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
23 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limits for payment  
24 of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Oregon Business Development  
25 Department, for the following purposes:

- 27 (2) Business, innovation  
28 and trade..... \$ 59,333,558

31 **SECTION 13.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, expenditures by the Oregon Busi-  
32 ness Development Department are not limited for:

34 (a) Oregon Business Development Fund (ORS 285B.092), Oregon Entrepreneurial Devel-  
35 opment Loan Fund (ORS 285B.758), Credit Enhancement Fund (ORS 285B.215) and Small  
36 Business Expansion Loan Fund (ORS 285B.133).  
37 (b) Special Public Works Fund (ORS 285B.455), Water Fund (ORS 285B.563), Marine Nav-  
38 igation Improvement Fund (ORS 777.267), Oregon Port Revolving Fund (ORS 285A.708), Safe  
39 Drinking Water Revolving Loan Fund (ORS 285A.213), Brownfields Redevelopment Fund (ORS  
40 285A.188) and Oregon Brownfield Properties Revitalization Fund (ORS 285A.198).

41 (2) Debt service, excluding debt service on lottery revenue bonds and general obligation  
42 bonds.

43 **SECTION 14.** This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
44 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect  
45 July 1, 2025.
