

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5049

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

March 17

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after the semicolon insert “amending sections 3, 20, 25 and 27,  
2 chapter 598, Oregon Laws 2023;”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 15 and insert:

4 “**SECTION 1.** Section 3, chapter 598, Oregon Laws 2023, as amended by section 1, chapter 106,  
5 Oregon Laws 2024, is amended to read:

6 “**Sec. 3.** The following amounts are allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, from the  
7 Administrative Services Economic Development Fund, to the Oregon Business Development Depart-  
8 ment, for the following purposes:

9 (1) *Operations*..... \$ 16,970,908]

10 **Operations**..... \$ 17,091,190

11 (2) Business, innovation

12 and trade..... \$ 76,741,709

13 (3) Infrastructure..... \$ 18,828,531

14 (4) Oregon Film and Video Office..... \$ 1,479,463

15 “**SECTION 2.** Section 25, chapter 598, Oregon Laws 2023, is amended to read:

16 “**Sec. 25.** (1) There is allocated to the Oregon Health Authority for the biennium beginning July  
17 1, 2023, from the Criminal Fine Account, the amount of \$42,884 for the purpose of grants under ORS  
18 430.345 for the establishment, operation and maintenance of alcohol and drug abuse prevention,  
19 early intervention and treatment services provided through a county.

20 “(2) There is allocated to the Law Enforcement Medical Liability Account established under  
21 ORS 414.815, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, from the Criminal Fine Account, the amount  
22 of \$1,300,000.

23 “(3) There is allocated to the Oregon State Police for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, from  
24 the Criminal Fine Account, the amount of \$351,572 for the purpose of enforcing the laws relating  
25 to driving under the influence of intoxicants.

26 “(4) There is allocated to the Department of Corrections for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023,  
27 from the Criminal Fine Account, the amount of [~~\$5,197,236~~] **\$0** for the purpose of planning, operating  
28 and maintaining county juvenile and adult corrections programs and facilities and drug and alcohol  
29 programs. Notwithstanding ORS 137.300 (4), the grant to each county shall be based on the formula  
30 used to determine the distribution of moneys under the Grant-in-Aid Program under ORS 423.530.

31 “(5) There is allocated to the State Court Technology Fund established under ORS 1.012, for the  
32 biennium beginning July 1, 2023, from the Criminal Fine Account, the amount of [~~\$3,887,500~~]  
33 **\$2,927,500**.

34 “(6) There is allocated to the Intoxicated Driver Program Fund created under ORS 813.270, for  
35 the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, from the Criminal Fine Account, the amount of \$4,323,000.

1 “(7) There is allocated to the Oregon Health Authority for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023,  
2 from the Criminal Fine Account, the amount of \$331,824 for the Emergency Medical Services and  
3 Trauma Systems Program created under ORS 431A.085.

4 “(8) There is allocated to the Department of Revenue for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023,  
5 from the Criminal Fine Account, the amount of \$100,000 for administrative costs of the department.

6 “**SECTION 3.** Section 27, chapter 598, Oregon Laws 2023, as amended by section 12, chapter  
7 106, Oregon Laws 2024, is amended to read:

8 “**Sec. 27.** (1) There is allocated to the State School Fund established under ORS 327.008, for the  
9 biennium beginning July 1, 2023, from the Oregon Marijuana Account, the amount of \$40,750,659.

10 “(2) There is allocated to the Oregon Health Authority, for mental health treatment or for pur-  
11 poses related to alcohol and drug abuse prevention, early intervention and treatment services, for  
12 the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, from the Oregon Marijuana Account, the amount of \$20,375,329.

13 “(3) There is allocated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the health systems division, for the  
14 biennium beginning July 1, 2023, from the Oregon Marijuana Account, the amount of \$5,093,832 for  
15 purposes related to alcohol and drug abuse prevention, early intervention and treatment services.

16 “(4) There is allocated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023,  
17 from the Oregon Marijuana Account, the amount of [~~\$190,824,043~~] **\$189,919,226**, for deposit into the  
18 Drug Treatment and Recovery Services Fund.

19 “(5) There is allocated to the State Police Account established under ORS 181A.020, for the  
20 biennium beginning July 1, 2023, from the Oregon Marijuana Account, the amount of \$15,281,497.

21 “**SECTION 4.** Section 20, chapter 598, Oregon Laws 2023, is amended to read:

22 “**Sec. 20.** (1) Notwithstanding ORS 137.300, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, the De-  
23 partment of Revenue shall [*distribute the moneys in*] **establish a process for distributing available**  
24 **moneys on a monthly basis from** the Criminal Fine Account established by ORS 137.300 [*as*  
25 *specified in*] **to fulfill the biennial distributions made by** sections 21 to 25 [*of this 2023 Act*],  
26 **chapter 598, Oregon Laws 2023.**

27 “(2) **If the moneys from the Criminal Fine Account are insufficient to pay for the**  
28 **monthly distributions under subsection (1) of this section, the department shall reduce the**  
29 **monthly distributions proportionately in amounts sufficient to accommodate the revenue**  
30 **shortfall.**

31 “**SECTION 5.** **This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
32 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect**  
33 **on its passage.”.**
