

# Senate Bill 1030

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON HUMAN SERVICES

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells RCFs to offer certain vaccines to residents. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.3).

Requires a residential care facility, including a facility with a memory care endorsement and an assisted living facility, to make available to residents at least one on-site vaccine clinic per year.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to vaccine clinics in residential care facilities.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 443.400 to**  
5 **443.455.**

6 **SECTION 2. (1) From October 1 through March 1 of each year, a residential care facility,**  
7 **including a facility with a memory care endorsement under ORS 443.886 and an assisted liv-**  
8 **ing facility, shall make available to residents at least one on-site vaccine clinic. The clinic**  
9 **shall administer vaccines for at least the following diseases:**

10 (a) **Influenza;**

11 (b) **COVID-19; and**

12 (c) **Pneumonia.**

13 (2) **A resident has a right, but is not required, to participate in a vaccine clinic.**  
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**NOTE:** Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
